Reporting

Snapshots & Reports: Parents are updated on student progress through a series of regular Snapshots and Reports. Mid-term, families receive a Snapshot report indicating their student's progress throughout the term. Reports, with grading of A - E are then provided at the end of each semester.

Parent / Student / Teacher Interview: Students have the opportunity to take part in Parent / Student / Teacher interviews at the end of terms 1 and 3. These interviews are a great opportunity to meet with teachers and discuss progress, achievements and address any issues.

SEQTA

SEQTA is a web-based learning management system that provides students and families with real time information about timetables, attendance, assessment tasks, marking of summative work and student reports. SEQTA is accessible 24/7 from anywhere with internet access. It's a secure system which requires a unique username and password.

SEQTA Engage is the Parent Portal, and is available online from a link from our school website www.whs.sa.edu.au and is also available as an App that can be downloaded from the app store for both Android and IOS devices.

Through SEQTA, you will be able to engage in the education of your child:

- View upcoming assessments
- View marked assessments and teacher feedback
- View relevant school notice information
- Track upcoming homework
- View and monitor attendance
- Access academic reports

A Username and password will be emailed to all new families at the start of the school year and a reminder email will be sent to all who haven't yet signed in to SEQTA at the start of each term.
