Reports

All students in Years 8-11 in 2018 will have a report along with an Instrumental Music report if your child is in this program. Students in Year 8 2019 will have a transition letter.

Uniform

The school's uniform policy is included. All uniform is available for purchase from the school and an order for has also been included for your convenience.

Stationery

As most student work will be completed electronically students will require access to a laptop and a USB to save work. An indicative stationery list is included for students who will be in Years 8 and 9 in 2019 to assist families to be prepared for the start of the 2019 school year. These items can be purchased from any local stationery supplier. Senior school students should have basic stationery items such as a lined pad or workbook and writing implements. Information on any additional stationery requirements will be provided to students by their subject teachers during the first lesson.

Materials and Services Charge

The 2019 Materials and Services Charge for your child/ren is included in this package along with any applicable subject fees.

During Term 4 2018 the Governing Council sought support from the school community to set the Charge at a Prescribed sum of \$500 per student plus applicable subject fees. We are pleased to be able to advise that the wider school community supported this recommendation from Governing Council and therefore the whole amount of the Charge will be available to support curriculum delivery for your child/children.
