To support the learning of every student we are:

- supporting all teachers to establish appropriate online learning resources in the SEQTA learner management system.
- investigating opportunities to provide video conferencing for staff and students.
- planning activities, units and learning tasks with flexibility and adaptability:
  - o establish learning intentions, due dates, submission processes and formative / summative feedback loops.
  - o establish how children might record their experiences to share.
- planning units and learning tasks with flexibility and adaptability that can be delivered online.
- planning for differentiated support so that children and students' learning and needs are accommodated.
- planning learning programs in consideration of individual learning plans.
- preparing home learning materials, for example, games, puzzles, texts, resources, workbooks, and novels.

SEQTA provides the following opportunities for online learning to support our commitment above:

- Online forums where students can interact in real time with their peers and teacher.
- Correspondence via email, SEQTA direct message and SEQTA text.
- Detailed lesson plans and resources uploaded by the class teacher, and kept up to date, on the online lesson organiser.
- Students can submit drafts, final copies and receive feedback from teachers through the SEQTA marks book.
- SEQTA Phone App is available to download through the App Store (Apple) or Play Store (Android)

As advice we receive changes or is updated we examine and review the measures we have in place and make any necessary changes to ensure that we have the safest environment for students and staff.
