Year 12 Formal postponed

This week the Willunga High School leadership team met to consider directions to support the effort to contain and slow the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) as preschools and schools play a vital role in assisting our communities to contain the virus.

Due to directions and guidelines sent out by SA Health and the Department for Education, and after much discussion, we have made the decision to postpone the year 12 formal which was set to take place on Friday 27 March 2020 at Serafino Winery.

Please understand that we have not taken this decision lightly and we also understand that this may impact on previous commitments you may have made.

At this stage the year 12 formal for 2020 has been postponed until Friday 18 September. The formal will remain at Serafino and will continue in a similar fashion to our previous communication. As new information is available we will continue to review and reassess our ability to hold this event.

Due to the postponement, the new deadline for final payment of formal tickets has been extended until Friday 4 September.
