Dear Parents/Caregivers

I hope that you are all well. Week 10 this term is exam week for year 11 students, however, due to the fact that we extended our semester to allow for our students to be successful during the home study faze, we have in many cases allowed course work to determine the student's grade rather than an exam.

There will be exams on Monday 29 June and Tuesday 30 June (see the table below). For the rest of the week students will work intensively on their Research Project.

The Research Project is a compulsory subject for students to achieve their South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) and is a semester long subject. By completing the Research Project in year 11, students give themselves the best possible opportunity to be successful in year 12 as they can utilise their time to complete their remaining four subjects to gain an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR). If students wish to do a school based apprenticeship in year 12 they have the flexibility to work and attend Trade School, with their compulsories completed.

Students have already begun work in Pathways on their Research Project and in week 10 will be given an intensive week to get further work done. Students will have the opportunity that week to meet their Research Project teacher for semester 2. If students complete the requirements of the course before the end of the semester, we can negotiate for them to have a study line for the remainder of the semester.

Some students will also have the opportunity that week to complete the final assessment tasks in their compulsory mathematics and English.

Semester 2 will begin Monday 20 July 2020 (week 1, term 3).
