## SACE Information Evening

Over recent weeks in Pathways lessons, students have researched their career pathways and looked at the subjects that best suit their chosen pathway.

Our year 10 students have been working on the Personal Learning Plan (PLP) which is the first compulsory subject they must successfully complete to achieve their South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE). In 2021 they will be required to complete 2 semesters of English, 1 semester of mathematics and their Research Project as the remaining compulsory subjects towards their SACE.

Our current year 11 students will, by the end of 2020, have completed their compulsory PLP, mathematics, English and Research Project, as well as a number of choice subjects. This will leave them with 4 subject choices to make for year 12.

Family and school are integral support for our students as they complete their SACE. With that in mind, we would like to invite you to attend a SACE Information Evening to be held at Willunga High School on Thursday 30 July 2020 from 7.00pm to 8.00pm. We will give an overview of the SACE, introduce you to the senior school team and answer any questions that you have.
