COVID 19 restrictions have limited how schools are able to celebrate these occasions. We have needed to make a number of accommodations to comply with the current COVID 19 regulations put in place by our state government and health department.

The regulations we need to comply with include: social distancing, recording attendees for contact tracing and hygiene measures.

With this in mind we are determined to include families and caregivers in these celebrations as we feel that it is the combined support of families/caregivers and school that promotes student success.

To support us in complying with the current COVID 19 regulations we are asking that:

- all families/caregivers RSVP to invitations sent out for the Graduation and Awards Ceremonies so we can manage social distancing
- all families/caregivers 'check in' using the QR code provided at the entrance to the events, for contact tracing
- families/caregivers understand that when capacity of the gymnasium is reached, they will be seated in a different space with the event live streamed to that space
