



Dear families/caregivers,

Today the Premier announced a 7-day state-wide lockdown starting at 6pm tonight, Tuesday 20 July, through to at least 6pm Tuesday 27 July.

Direction from SA Health is that only the children of essential workers and vulnerable children will be able to attend our school during this time.

The school bus service will continue to operate if you need your child to attend because you are an essential worker. We will be here to support any student who arrives at school, a skeleton staff will provide supervision while they are here.

On Wednesday 21 July teachers will take the day to fine tune their online learning programs. Learning programs will resume on Thursday 22 July. Students will still need to engage in their normal learning program from this time onwards, using SEQTA in the first instance. Teachers will contact students to advise them of how their learning will be delivered.

More information will be provided as we work our way through the new COVID-19 Directions. Some immediate measures we are undertaking include:

- postponement of Stage 2 trial exams.
- cancellation of all excursions and camps over the next 2 weeks.
- requesting that parents do not enter the school grounds.

We are all making sacrifices to ensure our community remains as safe as possible. We appreciate that this is a significant undertaking for you and your family.

Willunga High School staff are committed to providing high-quality learning programs and wellbeing support for your child and will continue to do this over the coming weeks.
