HOW TO APPLY

- Visit the SAFSSA website at **safssa.eschoolsolutions.com.au** for detailed information about each course on offer
- Discuss the VET Readiness Orientation (VETRO) application process and requirements with your school's VET Leader, along with any financial costs associated with undertaking a VET course
- Select the industry pathway that you would like a career or qualification in, complete your SAFSSA Expression of Interest form and return it to the VET Leader at your school
- You will be required to undertake the VETRO process, RTO literacy and numeracy testing, and any information sessions held prior to acceptance in any course
- Students will be notified of enrolment into a course by the RTO upon successful completion of the application process







AGRICULTURE

Turn your love for the land into a career and learn about the latest practices in the agricultural industry including livestock breeding, animal health and nutrition, establishing pastures and cropping practices. Develop practical skills in operating and maintaining machinery and building stock fences. Gain the essential skills in agriculture that you need to work as a **Station or Farm Hand, Farm Foreman, Cropping Overseer, Machinery Operator.**

AUTOMOTIVE RETAIL, SERVICE & REPAIR

Gain knowledge about workplace safety along with skills in automotive fault finding and troubleshooting techniques in engines, automotive systems and components. You will also learn about the care and maintenance of automotive tools and equipment. Your gained skills will reflect the role of individuals who perform a range of servicing tasks in the **Automotive Retail, Service & Repair** industry.





BUILDING & CONSTRUCTION

This course teaches a broad range of foundational skills from across the construction industry trades. There are theory and practical training and assessment components to the course which provide a range of knowledge applicable to construction work sites. Direct career pathways include **Trades Assistants**, **Builders Labourer**, **Construction Assistant**, or use the knowledge gained as a pathway to an apprenticeship in a construction industry trade.

CIVIL CONSTRUCTION, RESOURCES & INFRASTRUCTURE

Gain practical and theoretical knowledge in a combined classroom and hands-on environment to make connections between your learning and industry application. You will learn WHS requirements, using power tools, carrying out measurements and calculations and working at heights skills. This course exposes students to a range of pathways such as **Truck Driving, Earthmoving, Building Site Preparation, Road Building, Mine Site Employment.**





ELECTROTECHNOLOGY

Embark on a career in the high-tech electrotechnology industry with this work entry program. It will teach you the basic skills and knowledge to work safely in any field of electrotechnology. The skills you will learn during this course will put you on the right path to become an apprentice **Electrician**, **Data Technician**, **Refrigeration & Air Conditioning Mechanic**.

MANUFACTURING & ENGINEERING

Gain a wide range of foundational skills and knowledge across engineering tasks, with a focus on practical activities using common engineering workplace tools and welding equipment. The skills you will learn from this course will put you on the right path to become a **Fabricator, Mechanical Engineer, Fitter & Turner, Boilermaker.**





PLUMBING

Through a mix of classroom-based study and workshops to practice hands on skills, you will learn about safe work practices, perform plumbing pipework, welding and fabrication, and use plumbing hand and power tools. The skills you will learn in this course can assist you on a pathway to become an apprentice **Plumber, Gas Fitter, Roof Plumber.**

HAIR & BEAUTY

Learn about salon services and protocols with this hands-on course. Develop your people skills in greeting clients in the salon. Gain the basic practical skills of working in a hair or beauty salon by learning about stock handling, visual merchandising, client sales and advice, as well as styling hair. From this course you will have the skills required to pursue a career as a **Salon Assistant** or as a pathway to a **Hairdressing Apprentice**.





HOSPITALITY & TOURISM

Develop your knowledge in a range of food preparation and cookery skills to prepare food and menu items. This provides a pathway that reflects the roles of individuals working in organisations such as restaurants, hotels, hospitals, aged care facilities and catering operations, in positions such as **Catering Assistant, Kitchen Hand, Front of House Staff.** It provides a pathway to further study in such areas as **Commercial Cookery, Chef, Kitchen Manager.**



EARLY CHILDHOOD

Early Childhood Education and Care - Gain knowledge to support children's health, safety and wellbeing by using an approved learning framework to guide practice. Learn skills to nurture babies and toddlers to support their learning and development. You will learn to identify and respond to children and young people at risk and provide First Aid in an education and care setting. Possible career pathways include **Early Childhood Educator**, **Education Assistant**, **Family Day Care Worker**, **Youth Worker**.





AGED CARE & DISABILITY

Learn how to work with diverse people, follow organisational procedures to collect routine client information and develop the skills needed to contribute towards ensuring the health and safety of clients in your care. Students will learn how to provide personal care, social and emotional support to a person with a disability or an older person. This will include training in first aid, manual handling, and working with culturally diverse clients. Pathways include but are not limited to **Aged Care Worker**, **Disability Support Worker**, **Home Care Assistant**, **Nurses' Aide**.
